Annual Report 2023–24

The academic year 2023–24 at Ahalia Public School was a year marked by significant achievements, innovative transformations, and memorable events that enhanced the holistic development of students. The school witnessed numerous advancements in academic excellence, infrastructure, co-curricular activities, and leadership development, making it a vibrant center of learning.

Leadership and Academic Reforms

A major milestone in the academic year was the appointment of **Mrs. Latha Prakash**, an accomplished educator and renowned CBSE trainer, as the Principal in May. Under her visionary leadership, the school implemented competency-based education, activity-oriented learning, and strategies to cultivate **21st-century skills** among students. Teachers received extensive training on the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**, differentiated learning strategies, handling learning difficulties, assessment methodologies, and the integration of **digital boards** in classrooms.

Academic Excellence

The academic year commenced with a proud announcement of **100% pass results** in the CBSE Class 10 and 12 board examinations. The school toppers included **Nithyaja T**, **Karthik B**, and **Samika V** from the Science, Commerce, and Humanities streams, respectively. In Class 10, **Mirna A** emerged as the topper, while **Angelina Antony** achieved a perfect score in Malayalam. The students and their mentor **Mr. Suresh Babu** were felicitated by both the school and the **Palakkad District Sahodaya School Complex**.

Infrastructure Development

The school witnessed a technological upgrade with the installation of **flat-screen digital boards** in collaboration with **TATA ClassEdge**, enhancing the teaching-learning experience through visual and interactive pedagogy. Regular training sessions ensured that teachers could effectively integrate these tools into their classroom practices.

Student Leadership and House System

The **Investiture Ceremony**, held on **June 30**, marked the formal induction of the new **Student Cabinet**, guided by their mentors. The event was graced by **Mr. V. Krishnankutty**, Circle Inspector of Police, Kozhinjampara, and **Mrs. Shreya Gopal**, Managing Trustee of Ahalia Group. The **Early Learning Centre** also held its own Investiture Ceremony on **August 31**, fostering leadership qualities in young learners. Students were divided into four houses – **Agni, Jal, Prithvi, and Vayu** – to encourage teamwork and healthy competition through **Interhouse Competitions** in art, literature, and sports.

Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities

The school promoted holistic development through **Special Assemblies**, conducted on Mondays and Wednesdays, providing students a platform to showcase creativity and communication skills. Classrooms adopted an activity-oriented learning approach, involving seminars, role plays, projects, and assignments.

Extra-curricular activities (ECA) were conducted on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Saturdays, with over **220 students** actively participating. Sports coaching in **football, athletics, and kabaddi**, led by the Physical Education Department, further enriched student life.

Major Events

The flagship event of the year was **Pragathi 2K23**, the **Palakkad District Sahodaya Kalotsav**, hosted by Ahalia Public School from **October 5 to 7**. With participation from nearly **4000 students across 64 schools**, the festival featured **146 literary and cultural events**. The Logo Release on **September 11**, and the subsequent preparations demonstrated the dedication and teamwork of the entire Ahalia community. Ahalia students secured notable accolades, including **third place in Kolkali and Group Dance (Category 2)**, along with several **A-grade performances**.

The school also celebrated important festivals and observances including **Gurupurnima, Independence Day, Onam, Teachers' Day, Children's Day, and Christmas**, fostering cultural appreciation and community spirit.

Kindergarten Initiatives

In the **Early Learning Centre (ELC)**, education was blended with exploration. Students participated in **Nature Walks**, experiential learning activities, and celebrations such as **Colour Day**, ensuring a joyful and holistic foundation in learning.
